Preschool - All Preschool students must be potty-trained prior to entering any Preschool classroom.

Registration is conducted starting in January for the following school year and the Registration Fee is due at the time this form is submitted. Current students have first rights to admission until February 1st at which time Open Registration begins. **All registration fees for students accepted at BSCS are non-refundable.** If a current student submits a Registration Form after Open Enrollment begins, they will be given first priority to any available slots at the time the Registration Form is submitted. If you are on Blessed Sacrament's admissions wait list and we are unable to offer you a spot for admission, your registration fee will be refunded. Once Blessed Sacrament Catholic School makes an offer to your child for admission, your registration fee becomes non-refundable.
